



2011-12 Student Assignment Zoning Plan

At a recent board meeting, minor zoning changes for about 900 incoming middle and high school students were proposed. A second reading and final vote is scheduled for the Feb. 8 board meeting. Elementary rezoning recommendations also will be proposed at the Feb. 8 meeting. Parents will have an opportunity to learn more about the recommended changes and ask questions at upcoming community listening sessions.
